2008 MUZIEKPARADE DETAILS

MARSHALS: The leading elements of the parade will move promptly from the initial point at 2:00p.m., Saturday, May 10, 2008.

Inform bands that their buses are parked at the east side of Van Raalte Avenue across the street from Holland High School (see map), except for Zeeland, which will be on 28th street, west of Van Raalte.

Vintage autos, floats, and convertibles in assembly area **BY 12:00 P.M.** *Floats are requested to stay to the rear of the division area until moved forward by division marshal.*

Bands and Corps in assembly area at **1:00 P.M.** with the exception of the Premiere Bands, who will be escorted to the assembly area after their performance.

PARADE ROUTE: Columbia Avenue, west on 8th Street, south on Van Raalte Avenue to Holland High School. Total length is 2.4 miles.

FIRST AID: The American Red Cross will be stationed at the SE Corner of 8th Street and Pine Avenue and at Holland High School. Each block from Columbia through 24th St. will have a mobile team.

DRUM MAJORS: The leading elements of the parade will move promptly from the initial point at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, May 10, 2008.

All bands and Corps shall be in parade formation by 1:00 p.m. The Premiere Bands will be put into parade formation upon completion of their performance.

Units are requested to maintain a cadence of between 120 and 130 steps per minute, using a minimum 22-1/2 inch (8 to 5) stride.

*A distance of 15 yards shall be maintained between units. There shall be **NO COUNTER MARCHING, DANCING, OR DRILLING** in route. Reviewing stand will be between Pine and Maple Avenues at the Northeast corner of the Civic Center Building. Please have your band play at the bleachers and at the various radio and television broadcast booths located along the parade route.*

HOLLAND HIGH SCHOOL: Tulip Time will again this year be providing beverages for each parade participant at Holland High School at the end of the parade. Please have one or two of your members go to the truck and pick up sufficient product for your group. *Because of the State of Michigan Returnable Container Law, all beverage cans must be collected and returned to the dispensing area when empty.*

DUTCH DANCE BANNER CARRIERS: Please meet Parade Chairman, Bob Sumrall, at the beginning of the parade route on Columbia Ave. & 8th St. to pick up your banner.

REST ROOMS: Holland High School East Unit. Assembling area rest rooms are in the form of port-a-johns placed throughout the lineup area.



BAND AND CORPS MANAGERS: We have designed this parade so that everything will run as smoothly as possible. While we try to change positions of units participating from each, please understand that there are many factors which may account for your parade position. Certain sized units must be placed in specific spots in order to balance the formation. Also, we try to place some larger and smaller units in each division. This results in a smooth operation in a limited time.

IMPORTANT: There have been some problems in the past with chaperones, family, friends, etc., following behind bands or drill teams on the parade route. This practice is distracting to the parade and **ABSOLUTELY WILL NOT BE PERMITTED**. Marshals are instructed to remove such persons at the start of the parade. Persons who wish to meet their band at the end of the route should make arrangements other than walking along the parade route.

FLOAT TEAR-DOWN: All privately built floats will be expected to leave the parade route and tear down on 29th Street going east (left) from Van Raalte Avenue. Stay to the south side of 29th Street. Commercially built floats by Great Lakes Parade Floats will be expected to leave the parade route and tear down on 27th Street going west (right) from Van Raalte Avenue. **PLEASE NOTE: Each float must have its own tow vehicle. Anyone who abandons a float anywhere at the end of the parade WILL NOT be invited to participate again and their float may be impounded.**

PARADE BALLOON INFLATION: Inflation area is east of The old Pietro's Restaurant on 8th Street, between Lincoln and Columbia Avenues (across from the Post Office). Inflation should be completed by no later than 1:30 PM to prevent delays in the parade. Deflation area is at Holland High School.

EQUESTRIAN GROUPS: Assembling/Hitching area will be on 10th Street, east of Columbia Avenue, except Division I entries. Division I entries will assemble/hitch in The Grand Rapids Press parking lot. **REMINDER: Each equestrian unit must provide a clean-up crew that will follow directly behind the horse(s) and clean up any solid waste deposited on the road by the horses.** This will ensure maximum safety for the parade units following the equestrian unit.

GUIDELINE ADHERENCE: The Tulip Time Board has determined that strict adherence to the above guidelines is mandatory, *particularly in regard to eliminating parade gaps*. Units not cooperating fully may not be invited again to participate in future Tulip Time parades. Many units are turned away each year, once the optimum size parade is reached. We therefore expect full cooperation from units accepted for Tulip Time parades.
