


GROUP MEALS

The Gentex Kinderparade and Quality Car Wash Volksparade are can't miss features of Tulip Time. On Thursday, May 11, elementary school children will line up in full costume and smiling faces for the Gentex Kinderparade and march together through downtown Holland. On Saturday, May 13, The Quality Car Wash Volksparade will display street scrubbing by volunteers from the community. Both parades will feature floats and marching bands and unique entertainment.
